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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

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Our Religious Education program offers a comprehensive background in the basic tenets of our Catholic faith for children ages 6-16, as well as sacramental preparation for both First Communion and Confirmation.

Classes are held each Sunday morning from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM September through early May.

There is a great deal of material to cover during each class session so it is **ESSENTIAL** for children to arrive **ON TIME (10 AM)** and **REMAIN UNTIL CLASS ENDS (11:00 AM)**

Again, due to the amount of material covered each week, it is **ESSENTIAL** for students to attend every class. We understand that family commitments, illnesses, etc. may arise so please carefully read the following requirements:

- Families **must inform the Director of Religious Education** if their child(ren) will not be in class.
- For safety reasons, if a child is not in class and the Director of Religious Education has not been notified by the family, he will reach out to the family to ensure that the child(ren) should not be present that day.
- Students who miss **more than 5 classes** throughout the year will have to repeat the level during the following year; if a student is preparing for a sacrament, he/she will have to wait until the following year and complete the required preparation at that time.
- Students are expected to treat their instructors and the other students with kindness and respect. If a student is not living up to this expectation, the family will be notified.
